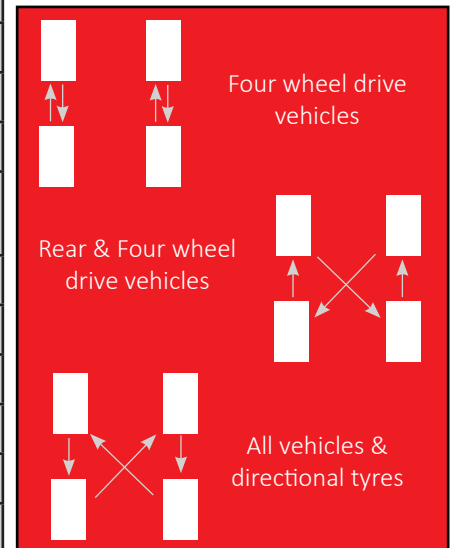

Kumho Solus TA11 Kilometre Guarantee **50,000km / Three Years**

Welcome to the World of Kumho Tyres. This is Kumho Tyres "kilometre guarantee". You will get a minimum of 50,000km out of your Kumho tyres within three years or we will give you a credit based on the calculation below on your next purchase of Kumho tyres. Keep this form in a safe place with your proof of purchase, service your tyres in accordance with our maintenance programme and enjoy many kilometres of happy motoring.

Conditions to be met for guarantee to apply:

- You must return the section below completed with a copy of the original purchase invoice.
- This warranty is not transferable and only abides while the purchaser uses and owns the vehicles.
- If the tyres wear down to the tread wear indicators (ie, warrant of fitness standards minimum level) prior to 50,000km of normal passenger use and within three years of the date of purchase, Kumho Tyres will make an allowance for unused kilometres towards the purchase of a new Kumho tyre of the same size and type, pro-rated on warranted kilometres. The replacement allowance will be calculated by a percentage of the warranted kilometres not received multiplied by the original invoice price or current selling price (whichever is lower), of the tyre at the time and place of the adjustment. The actual kilometres received may vary from the coverage kilometres listed because driving habits and driving conditions vary. Nevertheless, the tyre(s) may be replaced subject to the terms and conditions described.
- Each 10,000km the tyre must be serviced and the position changed. This is to be done by an approved dealer and signed and stamped. Phone 0800 80 90 96 for confirmation of an approved dealer.

- Services supplied by the Kumho dealer will be charged for at the normal dealer rate.
- The service check details must be completed correctly to get a claim.
- In the event of a claim, the vehicle and 10,000km service check details must be returned to a Kumho dealer.
- Pro rata is paid out on the original invoice amount.
- Tyres must be used for the purpose they were designed for.
- Kumho reserves the right to decline above warranty for various reasons and may offer a reduced kilometre warranty.
- Kumho's decision is the final and no disputes will be entered into between parties.
- PURCHASER REQUIRED TO PAY FOR DEALER SERVICES AND TAXES. The cost of mounting, balancing, alignment and any other charges by the dealer in connection with the replacement of the tyre are required to be paid by you.
- Consequential damages excluded, Kumho Tyres and the selling Dealer are not responsible for any special incidental, indirect or consequential damages or losses, including, but not limited to, loss of time, loss of profits, inconvenience, loss of the use of the vehicle or costs associated therewith.
- Guarantee is only valid from three years after the purchase date.
- Tyres are for normal passenger use as per vehicle and tyre manufacturers specifications.
- This guaranteed relates only to claims made on the original purchase price or current selling price (whichever is lower).
- Once the guarantee has been claimed the guarantee ceases to exist.
- The sale price includes the cost of the guarantee.

Not covered:

- Road hazard injury (eg impact damage, cuts, punctures).
- Separation caused by puncture.
- Under or over inflation.
- Mechanical irregularities causing uneven or rapid wear.
- Incorrect mounting of tyres, including incorrect rim size.
- Balance problems after the first 1.5mm of treadwear.
- Ozone, weather, fire, chemical corrosion etc damage.
